## The following items were discussed:

Mayor Kennon and Councilmembers proposed formulating a cohesive vision with the assistance of the Planning Commission for future development projects in Orange Beach. Mayor and Council expressed a desire to limit zero lot lines and five-foot setback projects, and an interest in increasing the supply of single-family residences to attract families to Orange Beach in conjunction with the new Orange Beach schools, Related issues discussed included:

- 1. Affordable housing
- 2. Residential projects in GB (General Business) zones
- 3. Leaving space for sidewalks
- 4. Enforcing and/or increasing parking requirements
- 5. Diversity in construction
- 6. Zoning to protect property values
- 7. Property rights
- 8. Requiring fire sprinklers for PUD (Planned Unit Development) projects
- 9. Requiring dumpsters as opposed to rollout trash cans for developments that support rentals
- 10. Promoting compatible uses through zoning

Mayor, Council, and Planning Commission were in agreement to take a look at the City's zoning ordinance and consider what changes might be best to promote a shared philosophy in guiding future development in Orange Beach.
